


## Q3 How did the Buyer finance the purchase? (Select one or more answers.)








# Q4 Where did the Buyer move from? If an Investor, choose where he/she is from even if not actually making a move. (Select one answer.)






## Q5 In what area was the property purchased? (Select one answer.)
